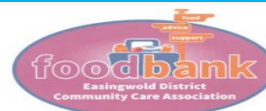

If some of these hours are suitable please do apply as hours can be negotiated.

- Provide safe creative, appropriate play opportunities and preparing activities
- Maintain accurate records as required to include completion of accident book, first aid and register of child's attendance
