Thank you very much for all of the responses that were received from the Parent Survey.

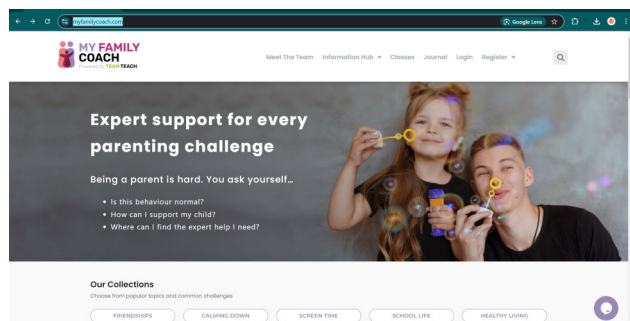
They were very much appreciated and help us greatly when looking at ways to make our warm and welcoming village school even better.

### Parents' Guide for Booking Appointments schoolcloud

Browse to <https://hubycofe.schoolcloud.co.uk/>

**Step 1: Login**  
Fill out the details on the page then click the *Log In* button.  
A confirmation of your appointments will be sent to the email address you provide.

**Step 2: Select Parents' Evening**  
Click on the date you wish to book.  
Unable to make all of the dates listed? Click *I'm unable to attend*.

**Step 3: Select Booking Mode**  
Choose *Automatic* if you'd like the system to suggest the shortest possible appointment schedule based on the times you're available to attend. To pick the times to book with each teacher, choose *Manual*. Then press *Next*.  
We recommend choosing the automatic booking mode when browsing on a mobile device.

**Step 4: Select Availability**  
Drag the sliders at the top of the screen to indicate the earliest and latest you can attend.

**Step 5: Choose Teachers**  
Select the teachers you'd like to book appointments with. A green tick indicates they're selected. To de-select, click on their name.

**Step 6: Book Appointments (Automatic)**  
If you chose the automatic booking mode, you'll see provisional appointments which are held for 2 minutes. To keep them, choose *Accept* at the bottom left.  
If it wasn't possible to book every selected teacher during the times you are able to attend, you can either adjust the teachers you wish to meet with and try again, or switch to manual booking mode.

**Step 7: Book Appointments**  
Click any of the green calls to make an appointment. Blue cells signify where you already have an appointment. Grey cells are unavailable.  
To change an appointment, delete the original by hovering over the blue box and clicking *Delete*. Then choose an alternate time.  
You can optionally leave a message for the teacher to say what you'd like to discuss, or raise anything beforehand.  
Once you're finished booking all appointments, at the top of the page in the alert box, press *click here* to finish the booking process.

**Step 8: Finished**  
All your bookings now appear on the My Bookings page. An email confirmation has been sent and you can also print appointments by pressing *Print*. Click *Subscribe to Calendar* to add these and any future bookings to your calendar.  
To change your appointments, click on *Amend Bookings*.
